



CSSDP PRESENTS YOUTH SPEAK: CANNABIS LEGALIZATION IN THE 21st CENTURY

On Wednesday, September 7th, Canadian Students for Sensible Drug Policy will be hosting a youth legalization roundtable focused on youth and young adults in the city of Toronto. The day will include an introduction to the proposed legalization regulations, highlight priority areas for young people, and workshop a series of topics in smaller groups before coming together to share ideas. We will take this feedback and produce an outcome document to be presented to the Legalization Task Force. Dr. Catherine Zahn from the Task Force will be present in the afternoon, along with a Senior Policy Analyst from the Legalization Secretariat. We also have the Honourable MP Nathaniel Erskin-Smith joining us for a portion of the day.
